**The Atlantic Harmony Brigade is pleased to announce the availability of up to \$16,000.00, in various awards intended to recognize, support and encourage the advancement and achievements of its members and their garnering of B.H.S. distinctions earned in pursuits that serve, bring attention and credit to "eXtreme Quartetting" and the mission of the A.H.B.**

The Awards:

- A) The Atlantic Harmony Brigade will reimburse the M-AD District contest registration fee of **ALL** quartets consisting entirely of active A.H.B Members who compete in the 2009 and/or 2010 M-AD District contest.

- B) A cash award in the amount of \$400.00 will be made to any quartet that consists entirely of A.H.B. members that win the 2009 and/or 2010 Mid-Atlantic District Novice Contest.
- C) Cash awards in the amount of \$200 will be made **to each** active Member of the Brigade whose quartet (with 3 or more active Brigade Members) reaches the 2009 and/or 2010 Mid-Atlantic District contest's top three places; an additional \$50 per man will be awarded if the quartet is entirely made up of active Brigade Members. An additional \$100 will be awarded to each active Brigade Member whose quartet places 1st in the District contest. **[Potentially up to \$1,400.00 for 1st Pl. at Mid Atlantic District Contest]**
- D) The contest registration fee for M-AD Prelims will be reimbursed to all quartets consisting of 3 or more active Brigade Members who qualify for International. Plus they will be given a lump sum of \$300 for travel reimbursement if they compete at international 2009 or 2010.
- E) \$500.00 will be awarded to each A.H.B. Member who is in a Quartet consisting of three or more active A.H.B. members if they compete at the 2009 and/or 2010 International Competition and if their quartet places in the top 10. An additional \$100 per man will be awarded if the entire quartet consists of active AHB Members. **[This is potentially up to \$2,400.00 for a A.H.B. quartet to reach top 10 at International]**
- F) Above and beyond "D" an additional \$2,000 will be awarded to any quartet consisting of all active AHB Members who place in the top 5 International quartets. **[This is potentially a grand total (when combined with "E" of \$4,400.00 for a AHB Quartet that reaches top 5 at International.**

The fine print:

The above awards may only be earned at the contests and events described above that are held between Jan 1, 2009 and Aug. 31, 2010; furthermore the following definitions and criteria applies as well:

In all cases "member(s)" and "active Member" means that the man/men has/have met all the criteria for A.H.B. membership in "good standing" at the time they participate in the above B.H.S. event(s) and they must be in attendance at the 2010 A.H.B. rally (at which time all the above A.H.B. awards and reimbursements will presented). All award recipients agree to actively endorse and champion the mission and spirit of the Brigade at the venue(s) where they qualified for the A.H.B. award. Reimbursement awards require that the recipient(s) submit receipts for the reimbursable expense immediately after the expense has been incurred but in no event later than 30 days prior to the 2010 A.H.B. rally. All individuals or quartets that qualify for any of these A.H.B. awards must contact and register proof of their qualification for the A.H.B. award with the A.H.B. Awards Registrar within 30 days of earning the qualification. All awards must be claimed at the 2010 AHB Rally. In the event that there is a dispute regarding the language, intent or awarding of these awards, the AHB and the claimant agrees to submit to binding arbitration of an impartial and unaffiliated panel of distinguished members of the Mid Atlantic District officers.
